The IBANGS 19th Annual Genes, Brain and Behavior (GBB) Meeting provides an excellent opportunity for those involved in research in the fields of behavioural genetics and neurogenetics to present their latest findings, to learn about new research developments, and to interact with others with similar interests. The 2017 GBB meeting will be held on the campus of the Complutense University of Madrid, Faculty of Medicine.

Madrid is the capital city of Spain. It is a modern metropolitan city with a population of nearly 3.5 million people which makes it the biggest city in Spain and the third most-populous metropolis in Europe (after Paris and London). It has 144 museums, almost 3,000 hours of sunshine per year, 6 public and 7 private universities, and more than 5,000 restaurants. Located on the banks of the Manzanares River, in the center of the Iberian Peninsula, 646 meters (2,119 feet) above sea level and is surrounded by mountains and natural parks. The city's many parks make Madrid the greenest city in Europe.
